Tiftarea Academy School Dance Dress Code Grades 8-12

Why do we have a dress code? The Tiftarea Academy administration and staff want you to make good choices. We are not trying to inhibit your style but are trying to develop an atmosphere that is appropriate for your age and to prevent inappropriate attire that might make others uncomfortable. With modesty in mind, the following dress code guidelines will be enforced at all Tiftarea Academy sponsored dances. While an administrator or staff member will be responsible for the interpretation of these guidelines, please understand that you will not be allowed into a dance if you are dressed inappropriately. Before a student is allowed to attend a TA sponsored dance, a contract stating an agreement to comply with the TA dress code (see student handbook) and the additional guidelines that are listed below must be signed by both the student and a parent or guardian.

Male Attire:

- Slacks or dress pants, button down shirts with collars, and a tie are required at all dances. Appropriate dress shoes are required also (no tennis shoes, etc.)
- Prom attire will include coat and tie as well as items mentioned above.
- No caps or hats, sunglasses, walking canes, or jeans are allowed.
- All males (TA and guests) must adhere to the Tiftarea dress code regarding length of hair and facial hair.

Female Attire:

- Cocktail dresses are appropriate; however, the hem should not be shorter than 5 inches from the bend of the knee.
- Dresses may not be cut below the bust line.
- Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the naval.
- Floor length dresses may not have a slit that exceeds fingertip length.
- Two-piece dresses are allowed; however, they must meet the above requirements. The midriff exposure should not exceed 3 inches.

Non-Tiftarea Academy Students:

- If your date is not a student at Tiftarea Academy, you are responsible for his or her attire meeting the dress code.
- Dance attendees must be in eighth grade and cannot be older than 20 years of age.

Arrival and Departure:

• Tiftarea students and their dates must adhere to the arrival and departure times set for dances.
